1. General

1.1 More House School is an independent school for girls aged 11 to 18.

2. Entry Procedure

2.1 Year 7: More House is part of *The London 11+ Consortium* (<http://london11plus.co.uk>) and thus operates an admissions process which is coordinated with all the other members of the Consortium. Entry is through a combination of Entrance Examination, Selection Day including an interview and reference from your daughter's present school. We produce special information sheets for parents to help them navigate the complexities of the Consortium system and our Registrar or support staff are always happy to help with telephone enquiries.

2.2 Applicants for admissions at 11+ should register as soon as possible in the year preceding the desired year of entry but no later than the closing date for admissions. For admission in September 2022 the closing date for registration is 12 November 2021.

2.3 Years 8 - 10: Although the main entry to the School is at Year 7 occasional vacancies occur for Year 8 and we also have a small additional intake into Year 9 and Year 10. Admission is through a CAT cognitive reasoning test, an interview with the Head and a reference from the pupil's present school.

2.4 Sixth Form: A girl wishing to join our Sixth Form will be offered a place following a successful interview with the Head and subject to a supportive reference from her present school. Required GCSE performance levels which will be established at the time of the offer and the place is then confirmed after GCSE results are announced in August.
